Vehicle Purchase & Sale Policy

Rationale

In order to deliver education services to home-based students, Northern Health School operates a fleet of vehicles. These vehicles are attached to various NHS units and are managed from Khyber Pass.

Purpose

To ensure that all NHS owned vehicles are of a suitable standard and are regularly replaced according to Board financial management and fixed asset policies and within relevant financial management guidelines.

Guidelines

- a) NHS will purchase new vehicles of a suitable safety standard.
- b) NHS vehicle purchase decisions will fit with the school's sustainability goals.
- c) NHS vehicles will be sign-written to a design and standard approved by the Principal.
- d) Vehicles which have been purchased new will be replaced within 4 years or when they have travelled no more than 80,000 km, whichever occurs first.
- e) A business case will be required for the purchase of any additional vehicles, not included in the budget.
- f) Vehicles will be disposed of in such a way as to provide the school with the maximum financial benefit.
